THE JOB:

The duties of this appointee will focus on the processing of meat and cleaning.

Meat processing involves precision cutting, preparing meat for the process of marinating, unpacking meat onto drying racks, hanging biltong etc.

Cleaning involves an array of cleaning tasks from cleaning tables, floors, machines, dishes, fridges, premises, windows, displays etc.

Although this person is going to work behind the scenes, your role could evolve into assisting customers and other tasks once you have accumulated enough knowledge and confidence. We will provide you with the training you will need to be successful in this role.

THE CANDIDATE:

The ideal candidate will be sensible, mature, have a great sense of humour and will be an excellent communicator. To stay on top of this job the successful applicant will need plenty of energy, physical strength and determination. This position also involves lifting of product (20 to 25 kg). Other key attributes to make a success of this job would be: Honesty, reliability and punctuality as well as a positive attitude and the ability to work under supervision.
